

Concentrated Concrete Cleaner

[Durável ECP](#) is a concentrated combination of detergents, degreasers, and acids that cleans and profiles concrete substrates in preparation for overlays, stains, and coatings. ECP is safer to use than muriatic acids and will not harm most plants or aquatic life. Using Durável ECP saves labor cost as there is no need to neutralize the substrate prior to the application of decorative products.

Coverage:

Usage will vary with application. Typically, one gallon of diluted product will clean and profile 250 to 300 square feet of concrete.

Directions for Use:

Mixing Instructions:

Durável ECP is concentrated and should be diluted with water prior to application. Pre-measure water and Durável ECP prior to mixing. Always add Durável ECP to the water to minimize the risk of splashing and harm. Replace container lids after each use.

For typical surface preparation use one part Durável ECP with two parts water. For general cleaning use more water, for more aggressive cleaning use less water. Always perform a test in an inconspicuous area to ensure that the surface is not damaged by the cleaning process before proceeding.

Dilution Ratio Suggestions, Water:ECP – (always dampen surface prior to application)

Straight	Difficult stains
2:1	Standard preparation for interior and exterior surfaces
3:1	Precast or recently poured concrete for surface latents
4:1	General cleaning or prior to re-seal

Application Instructions:

ECP reacts with concrete. Removing excess surface dirt and contaminants from the surface prior to using ECP will increase cleaning effectiveness.

Exterior: Remove dirt and other contaminants with a pressure washer fitted with a zero-degree rotating “turbo tip” nozzle. If the substrate is dry, first dampen the concrete with a mist of water and continue wetting as needed during the cleaning process. Apply the diluted product via pump-up sprayer or trigger sprayer onto the damp concrete. While the surface is wet agitate the liquid with a push broom or brush. Use a pressure washer fitted with a fan tip to rinse the surface thoroughly clean. Do not allow the product to dry on the surface prior to rinsing. Protect adjacent areas from overspray as needed. See below for warnings regarding metals

Interior: Remove dirt and other contaminants by appropriate means. If the substrate is dry, first dampen the concrete with a mist of water and continue wetting as needed during the cleaning process. Apply the diluted product via pump-up sprayer or trigger sprayer onto the damp concrete. While the surface is wet agitate the liquid with a push broom, brush, rotational floor scrubber, or auto scrubber. Use plenty of water to thoroughly rinse the floor clean. Remove rinse water with floor squeegees, a wet-dry vacuum, or auto scrubber. Do not allow the product to dry on the surface prior to rinsing. Protect adjacent areas as needed.

ECP and Metal

- Do not use on metals, especially aluminum. Product may produce flammable hydrogen gas if applied to aluminum, particularly aluminum foil.
- Product may damage stainless steel, galvanized metal, or magnesium.
- Copper and brass will be brightened but must be rinsed thoroughly

Storage:

Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed. Protect product from freezing.

Disposal:

Recycle and/or dispose of contents and containers in accordance with local, regional, national, and international regulations.
